


THIRD SUNDAY OF LENT-3/22-23



DURING LENT THIS YEAR, please join us in the parish hall to learn and reflect on the art of Pysanky Egg decorating. Pysanky eggs are traditional Ukrainian Easter eggs decorated using a wax-resist (batik) method. Pysanky eggs are rich in symbolism, with traditional motifs representing nature, prosperity, protection, and renewal. Historically, they were believed to have protective powers and were often given as gifts. The tradition has been passed down through generations and remains an important cultural and artistic practice in Eastern Europe. The dates we will be in

the parish hall are March 29 and April 12 from 9 AM to 12 Noon. All materials will be supplied (including eggs). Participants are just asked to bring paper towels and patience.

WE HAVE PLACED RICE BOWLS AT EACH ENTRANCE TO THE CHURCH We invite you to take one home with you. Our regular giving small change during Lent will be a wonderful reminder to us of the needy and hungry throughout the world and we will be helping them.
